BYLAW #678

A BYLAW TO SET THE SEWER PARCEL TAX RATE FOR 2006

WHEREAS Division 4 of Part 7 of the *Community Charter* (SBC Chap. 26) empowers the Council of the Village of Warfield to impose a parcel tax, and

WHEREAS it is Council's policy that a fair and reasonable share of the cost of operating and maintaining the sanitary sewer system is recovered by way of a parcel tax applied to certain residential parcels with access to the sanitary sewer service,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Warfield, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SHORT TITLE

1. (1) This Bylaw may be cited as the "**2006 SEWER PARCEL TAX BYLAW**".

PURPOSE AND CONDITIONS

2. (1) The parcel tax established with this Bylaw is levied for the purpose of providing the revenues necessary to finance all costs associated with the collection and treatment of sanitary sewer in the Village of Warfield.
- (2) The parcel tax established with this Bylaw is imposed for the year 2006.
- (3) A single amount for each parcel shall be the basis on which the parcel tax imposed with this Bylaw shall be assessed.
- (4) The assessment roll to be used for imposing the parcel tax established with this Bylaw shall be the "2006 Parcel Tax Assessment Roll Bylaw #672."
- (5) The amount of the parcel tax to be imposed shall be two hundred and five dollars (\$205.00).

ENACTMENT

3. (1) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the part that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

(2) This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the final adoption thereof.
