

**Columbia Basin Trust  
Community Initiatives Program  
2008/09**

The Community Initiatives Program is funded by the Columbia Basin Trust and is administered by the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary. The funding for the region has significantly increased with the amount of \$ 256,800.00 being available for distribution this year.

The Regional District Community Services Commission of Greater Trail has decided that the best course of action is to split the funds amongst the local communities on the basis of population. The allocation, based on the 2006 census, is as follows:
