

Property Taxes Coming Soon

Property tax notices will be mailed to homeowners at the end of May. If you have not received one by early June, please contact the office. Property taxes are due on **Tuesday, July 3, 2018** and all eligible homeowners

must claim their homeowner's grants by this date, even if you have claimed it before, to avoid penalty. More details can be found on your notices and questions may be directed to the office staff at 250-368-8202.

Fire Permits

Fire permits are required for backyard cooking fires from May 1-October 31 each year. They are free of charge and available from the Village Office.

A reminder that burning garbage, yard waste, and other items is not permitted in the Village. Yard waste pick-up is available every other Friday.

Be a Good Neighbour

This spring and summer, please practice good neighbor behavior and mind the noise bylaw #467 and observe quiet time between 11pm and 7 am, keep your dogs on their leashes, pick up and dispose of their waste, be mindful that water restrictions for lawn sprinklers run from June 15- Sept 15 unless otherwise indicated (bylaw #759), and there is to be no dumping of any matter anywhere in the village at any time.

SPRINGTIME ATTRACTANT MANAGEMENT CHECKLIST

- **Is your garbage securely stored?** All garbage should be locked in a secure building until the morning of collection
- **Have you taken down your birdfeeders?** Pack away your birdfeeders for the season and clean up any spilled seed.
- **Is your compost pile ready for the spring?** Turn your pile well and incorporate new material slowly and with plenty of 'browns' to ensure speedy decomposition.
- Are there any other attractants accessible to wildlife? Securely store attractants like recycling bins, pet food, gasoline/ diesel canisters and fertilizers indoors.
- If you have livestock, are your electric fences working optimally? Is your livestock feed stored securely?
