

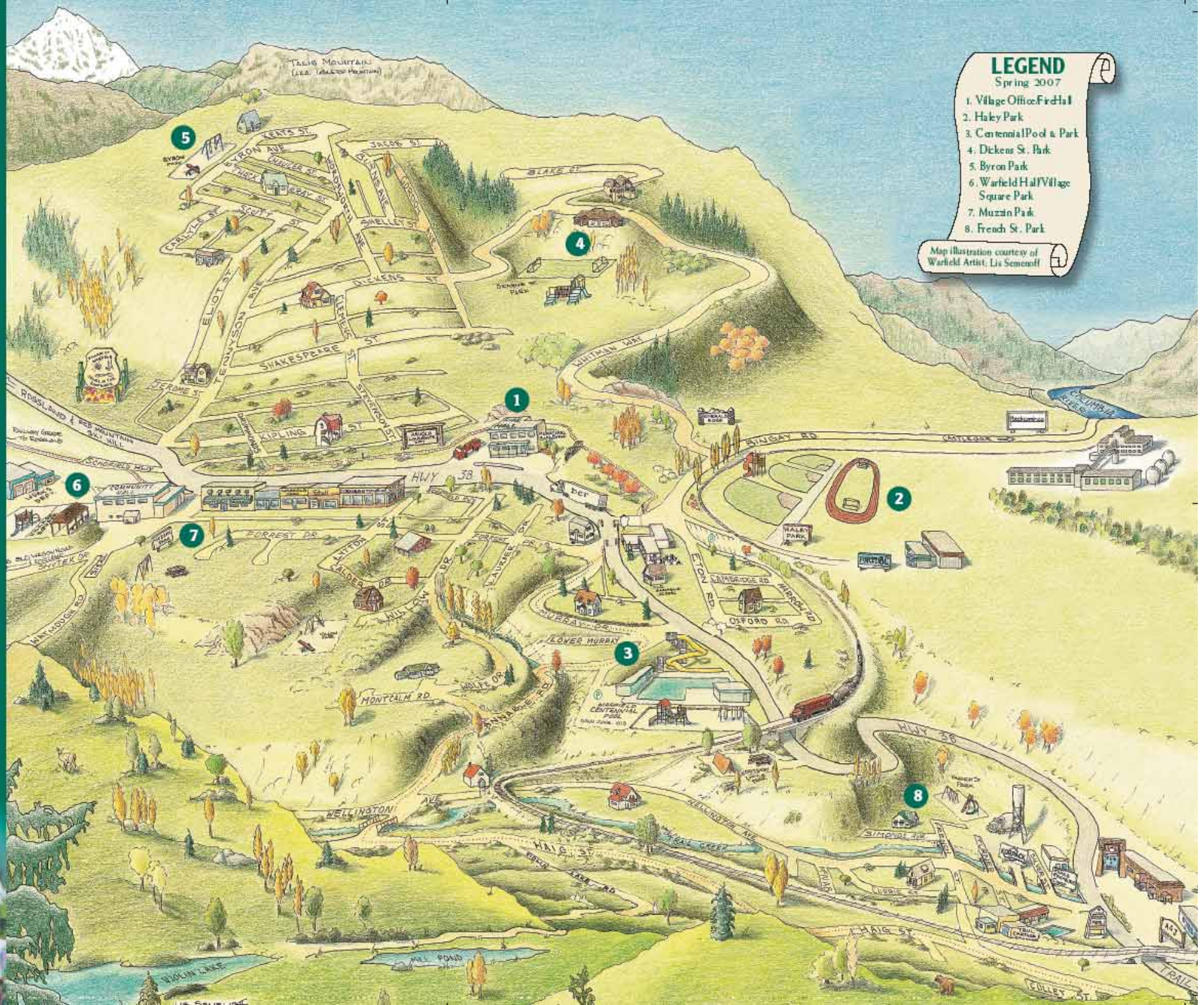

WELCOME

Welcome to the Village of Warfield – Jewel of the Kootenays!

Bordering the City of Trail to the east and Rossland to the west, Warfield is a small family focused community with a population just over 1700.

Warfield enjoys a number of community amenities that support family life. The heart of the community is the **Warfield Hall** and adjoining Village Square Park. Rarely does a season pass without some type of festivity there for the children, of all ages!

Family celebrations are organized by the Recreation Commission for Easter, Halloween, Christmas, and our legendary **Warfield Family Day**. The community also hosts an annual Senior's Celebration as well as a Recognition Gala for community volunteers.

Webster School... another Village facility serving residents and educating local children since 1949.

Parks, parks and parks... six neighbourhood parks are a source of endless fun and inspiration!

At the top of the Village is **Byron Park**. Next is the newly renovated **Dickens Street Park** with three tiers of playground equipment and playing fields. The **Village Square Park** is a family favourite with the firetruck playground, slide ride and BBQ picnic area. Directly below the

Village Square is **Muzzin Park** named after long standing mayor Isidore Muzzin. **French Street Park** is located in Annable in the base of the Village. It too boasts new equipment and a basketball court for all to enjoy!

Centennial Pool... In the summer this is the place to be in Warfield. As part of the Village's Jubilee Celebration the pool was completely modernized with the addition of two waterslides and a spray park and is now known as the **Kootenay Savings Water Park**. The adjoining playground was also retrofitted with all new equipment.

Linking the parks is a network of **trails and pathways** connecting residents to the walking routes in lower Warfield, Emerald Ridge, Wagon Road and the Rail Grade.

Arnold Lauriente Way connects the Warfield Hall to the School and to **Haley Park**, offering three ball fields, a soccer pitch, and complete track & field facilities.

The **Trans Canada Trail** bisects the Village winding its way from Annable to the Wagon Road.

It is easy to get around the community by foot – get active and challenge yourself on all the walking routes!
