Warfield has adopted a Food Charter and is currently recruiting for the new Food Advisory Committee.

The committee is being formed after the Village of Warfield officially adopted the Food Charter and Backgrounder Report in October. Starting in the spring of 2020, a diverse group of residents, farmers, and representatives from various organizations created these two guiding documents.
